Winter Sleigh by Pat Carothers

Experience: Intermediate

Class hours: 12 Noon to 9 pm (8 hours)

Cost: \$48.00

Basket Dimensions: 6" wide X 14" long X 9" high
(height will vary)

Base Choices: Dark Cherry Stain (as shown in the photograph), Black with Gold Runners, Unfinished



Description: Winter Sleigh is woven on a wooden base. Round reed spokes form the body and rolled rim. Several Color Combinations will be available for weaving the sides. Students will focus on shaping, working with round reed spokes, decrease weaving to form the front and back of the sleigh and a rolled border. Rolled border experience is helpful, but not necessary.



Autumn Splendor by Pat Carothers

Experience: All Levels

Class hours: 3 pm to 9 pm (5 hours)

Cost: \$30.00

Height: 8" wide X 8 1/2" long X 12" high
(with handle)

Description: Basket starts with a woven base and ends with a wrapped handle treatment and a splash of autumn leaves. Students will learn how to use round reed as a rim filler which continues up into the handle wrap.

Beaded by Pamela Wilson

Experience: All Levels

Class hours: 5 pm to 9 pm (4 hours)

Dimensions: 4" round, 1" high

Cost: \$45.00

Description: Basket will begin on a cedar base with predrilled holes. Students will learn several different coiling stitches and techniques including how to incorporate beads in a design. In this design beads will be layered on top of the stitches. Students may choose from a variety of designs on the bases, several colors of glycerin treated pine needles and artificial sinew and a selection of colorful beads to personalize their basket.

Tools: Needle nose pliers, angle cutters, basket scissors



Bedazzled By Pamela Wilson

Experience Level: All levels

Class Hours: 12 pm to 9 pm (8 hours)

Dimensions: 6" round x 1" high

Cost: \$65.00

Description: Basket will begin on a cedar base with predrilled holes. Students will learn several different coiling stitches and techniques including how to incorporate beads in a design. Students may choose from a variety of designs on the bases, several colors of glycerin treated pine needles and artificial sinew and a selection of colorful beads to personalize their basket.

Shaker Boxes by Dave Barnes

Experience Level: All levels.

Class Hours: 12 Noon pm to 4 pm (4 hours) **AND Sunday 9 am to 1 pm**

Cost: \$125.00

Description: This is a beginning level class where the student will build a set of 4 nesting Shaker boxes. Tools are provided by instructor: utility knife, drill press, band saw, power sander, steam box and hammer.

Tools: Non-folding utility knife with a new sharp blade

5-1/2" Nantucket Bowl by Candy Barnes

Experience Level: Beginner

Class Hours: 5 pm to 9 pm (4 hours)

Basket Dimensions: 5- 1/2" round

Cost: \$65.00

Description: Students will insert staves into a base and weave with cane around a class mold. Various colors will be available along with custom accents if desired. The turned rim will be glued on. Students will have a choice of cherry or black walnut.
